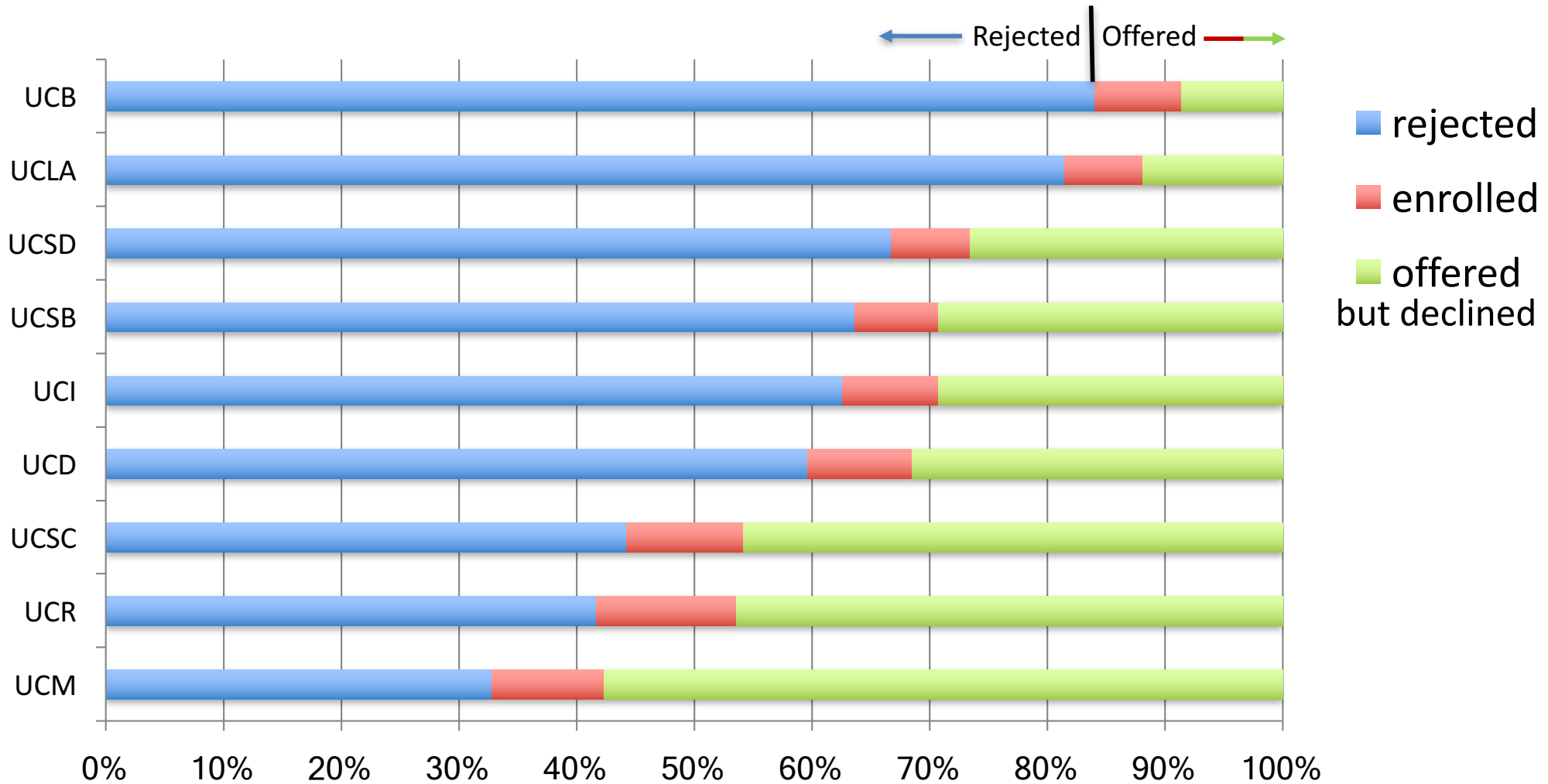


Freshmen enrollment statistics, University of California, 2014-15

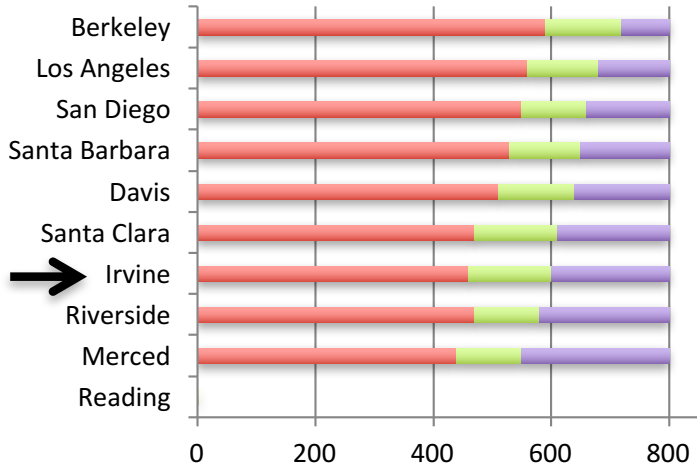


Note: Each bar represents the total total number of undergraduate applications, different for each school. The blue area represents the fraction of rejected applications. The remaining areas reflect the proportion of students that were offered admission, the red area represents the fraction of students that accepted and were ultimately enrolled.

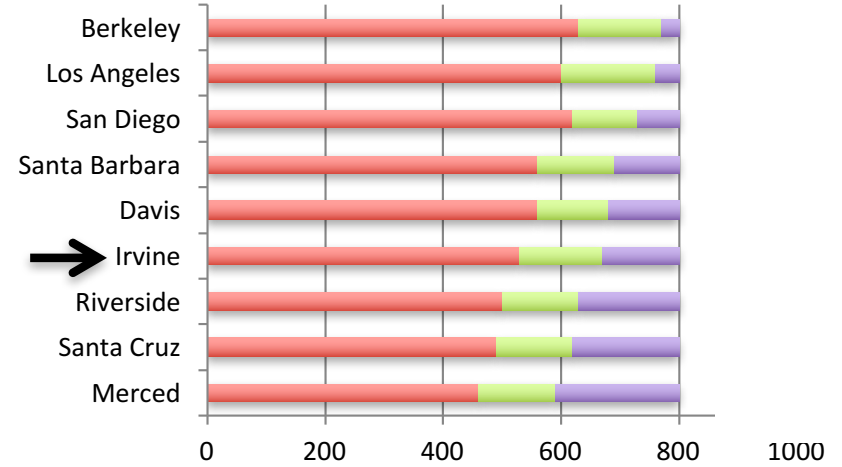

Entering Undergraduate Equivalent SAT Scores

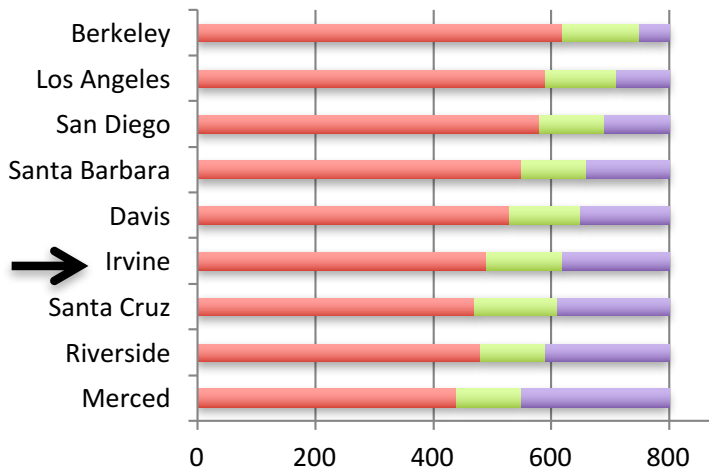
Reading SAT 2015-16 25%-75%



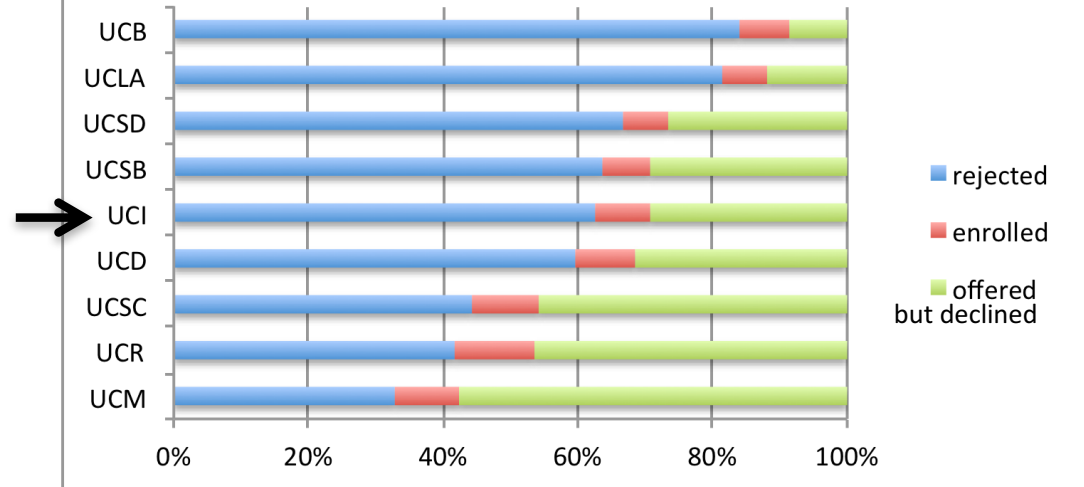
Math SAT 2015-16 25%-75%



Writing SAT 2015-16 25%-75%

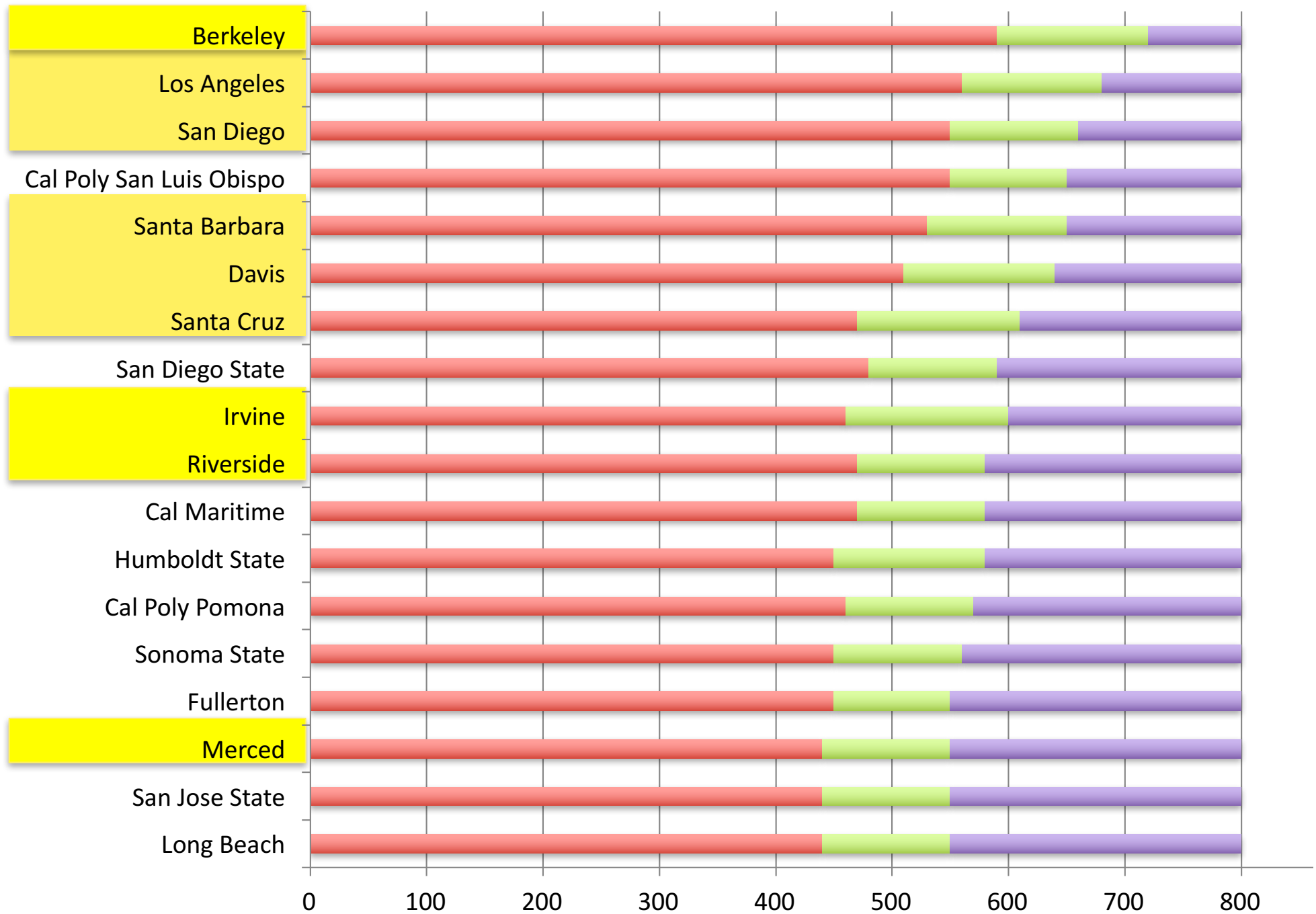

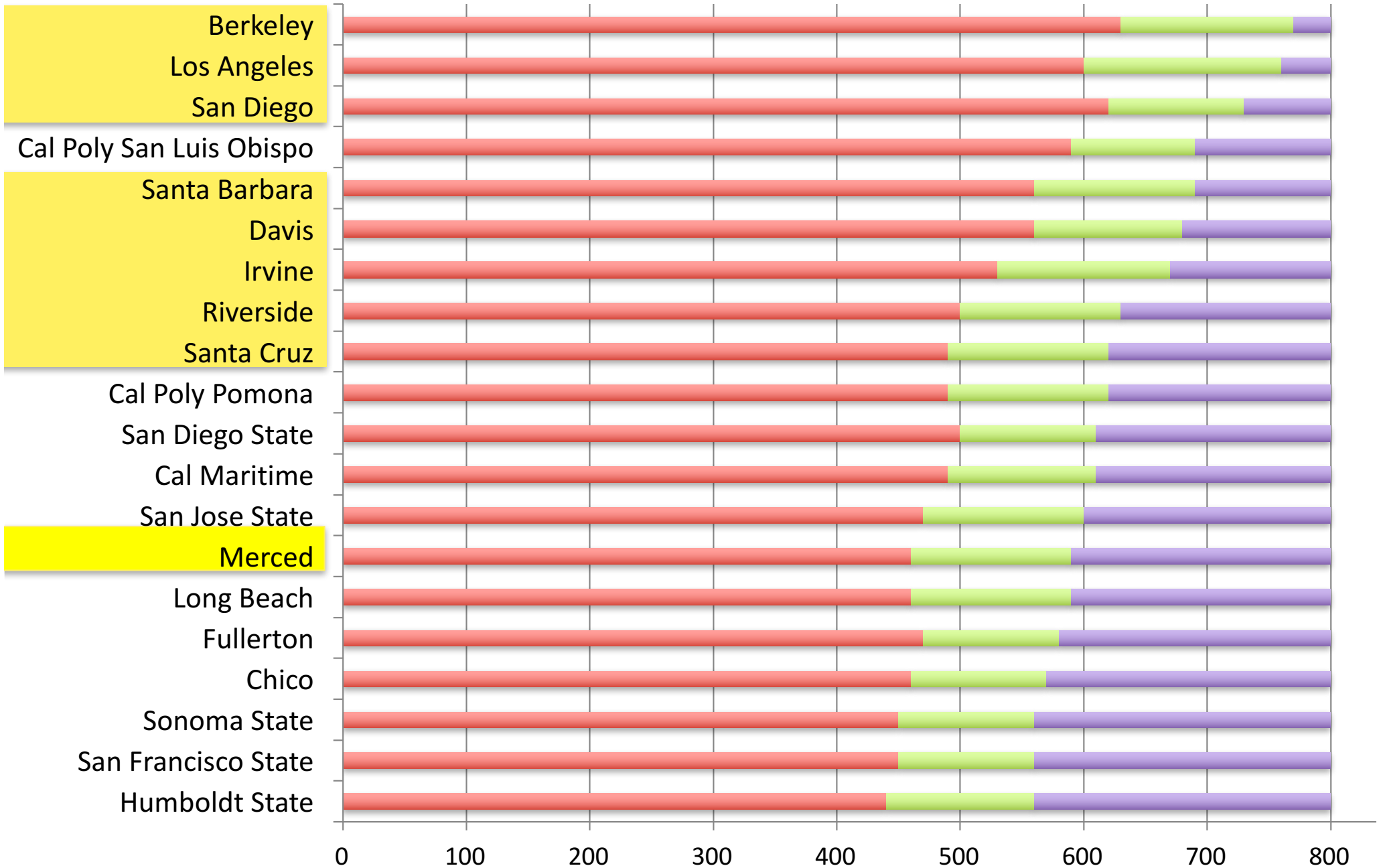


Note: Each bar represents the scores of entering undergraduates on ACT or SAT tests converted into equivalent SAT scores. The green areas represents the scores of the middle 50% of entering students, i.e., the values between the 25% and 75% percentile. The enrollment panel is copied from the previous slide. On Reading, Writing, Math SATs approx 75% of Berkeley entering undergraduates are above 600, 75% of UCI undergraduates are below.

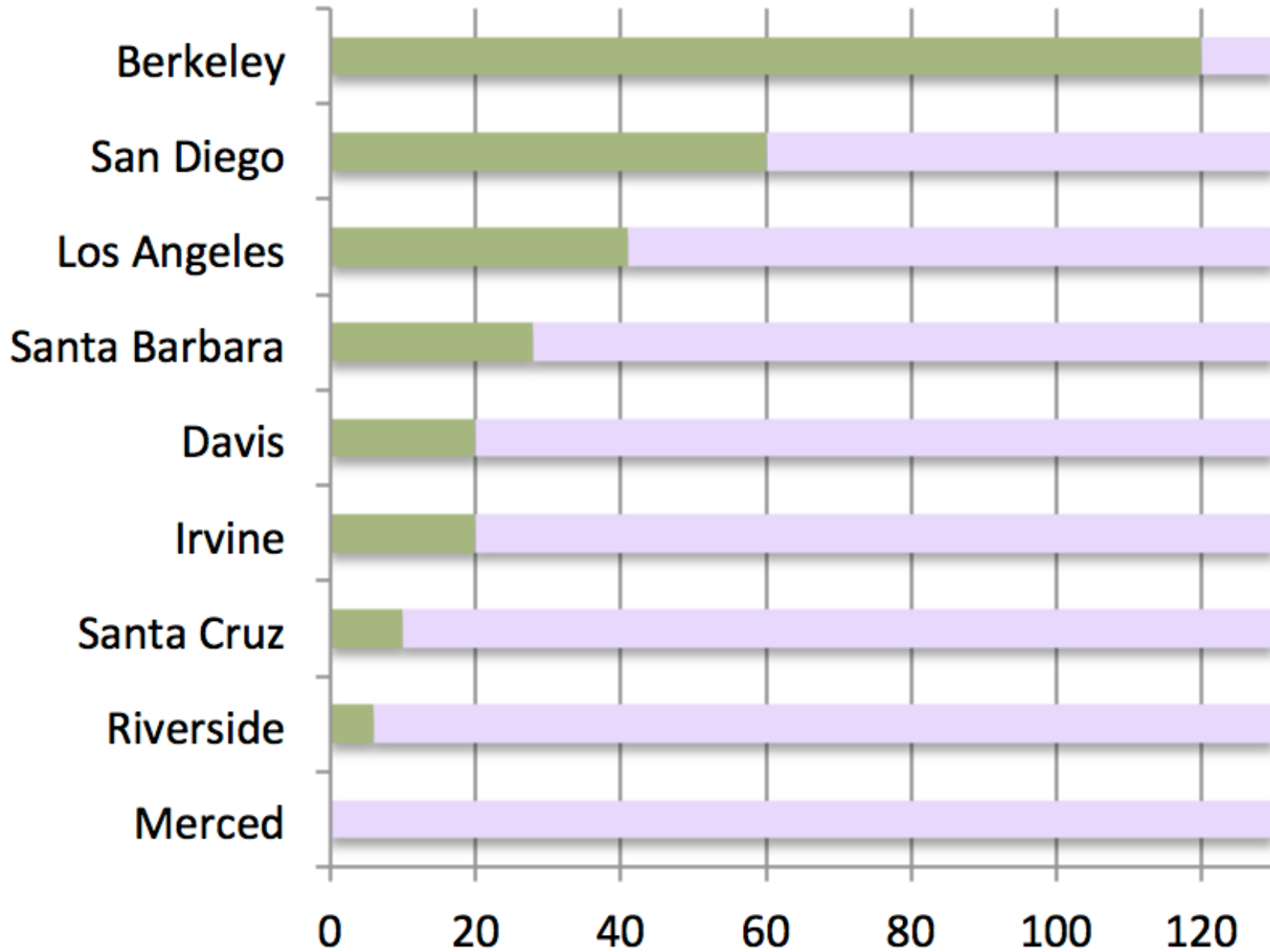
Reading SAT 25%-75% Scores for 2015-16 Enrollments at the top 9/21 Cal State and 9/9 UC Campuses
